RIGGS - Ready or Not/Take it Off/Over & Over/One Night Affairs. A fine taster for the album which is also called "Riggs". The first two tracks are on the heavier side with quite a polished pomp sound. The second two tracks are also quite excellent, in a different way. There is some lovely acoustic work with a warm relaxing solo on the first, while the second is a bouncy rhythmic song. Would make a good single.

SAMSON - Losing my grip/Pyramid to the Stars/Mr. Rock and Roll/Tomorrow or Yesterday. Set for release in mid-July, this 12" single has a good chance of getting into the charts. The chant chorus just might be commercial enough to make it. The second track reminds me very much of songs by Skynyrd as it has that special sort of classic feel. The other side contains two live tracks, both very powerful, the first of which has a great bluesy ending.

COLD CHISEL - You got Nothing I Want/Letter to Alan. An Australian band, this one. The 'A' side is very good, heavy yet commercial enough to make it into the charts. The vocals are extremely Bonnet-ish and I'll be surprised if it isn't a hit.

BERNIE TORMÉ - America/Chelsea Girls. On listening to America, you can see where the speed came from on the Mr. Universe/Glory Road albums. It's a good song but I feel the B-side would be better as a single. Nice lead-work.

TANK - (He fell in love with a) Stormtrooper/Blood, Guts and Beer (pic disc). This single is quite brilliant and I mean that. It's just too heavy to be true! This is what HM's all about - pure noise and proud of it. Support the cause and buy it. It's good value too considering it's a picture disc.

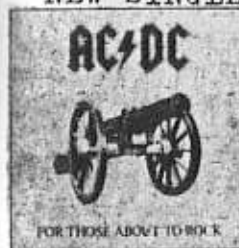
VARIOUS - ROCK SHOW THEMES - "Take it off the top" by Dixie Dregs (Friday Rock Show Theme); "Belgian Tom's Hat Trick" by Whitesnake (Rock On Theme) and "Pickin' the blues" by Grinderswitch (John Peel Show Theme). The best track on this single is the one you normally hear least of ie "Pickin' The Blues". Usually you get to hear only a couple of bars before the dulcid tones of Mr. Peel come over the air. Definitely worth buying just to hear it all the way through. The other two tracks aren't bad either.

SPARTA - Tonight/Angel of Death. A band on the Midlands pub and club circuit who are now extensively touring the country. "Tonight" is probably the better of the two songs as the other is a little disjointed. They are both good heavy rock songs with impressive lead work but they are not chart material. Their live performances are reported to be very good so watch out for them.
