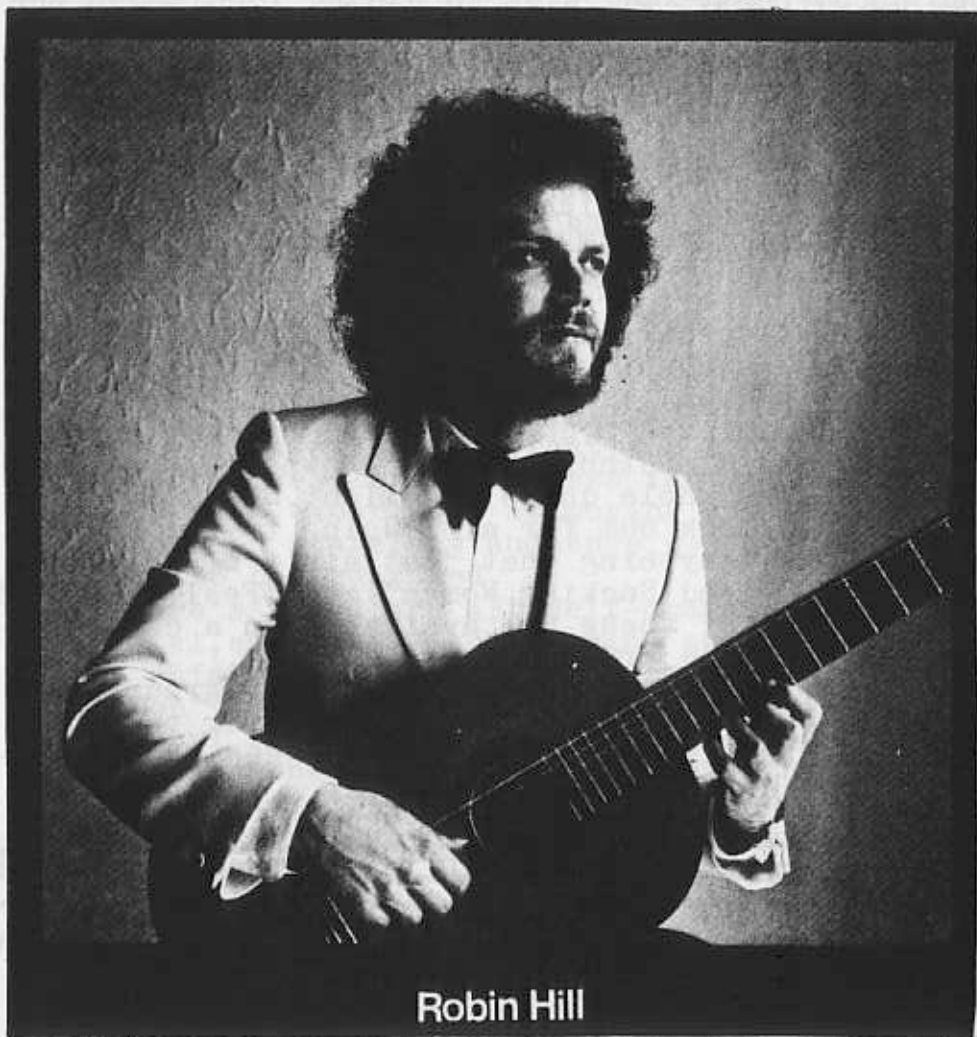


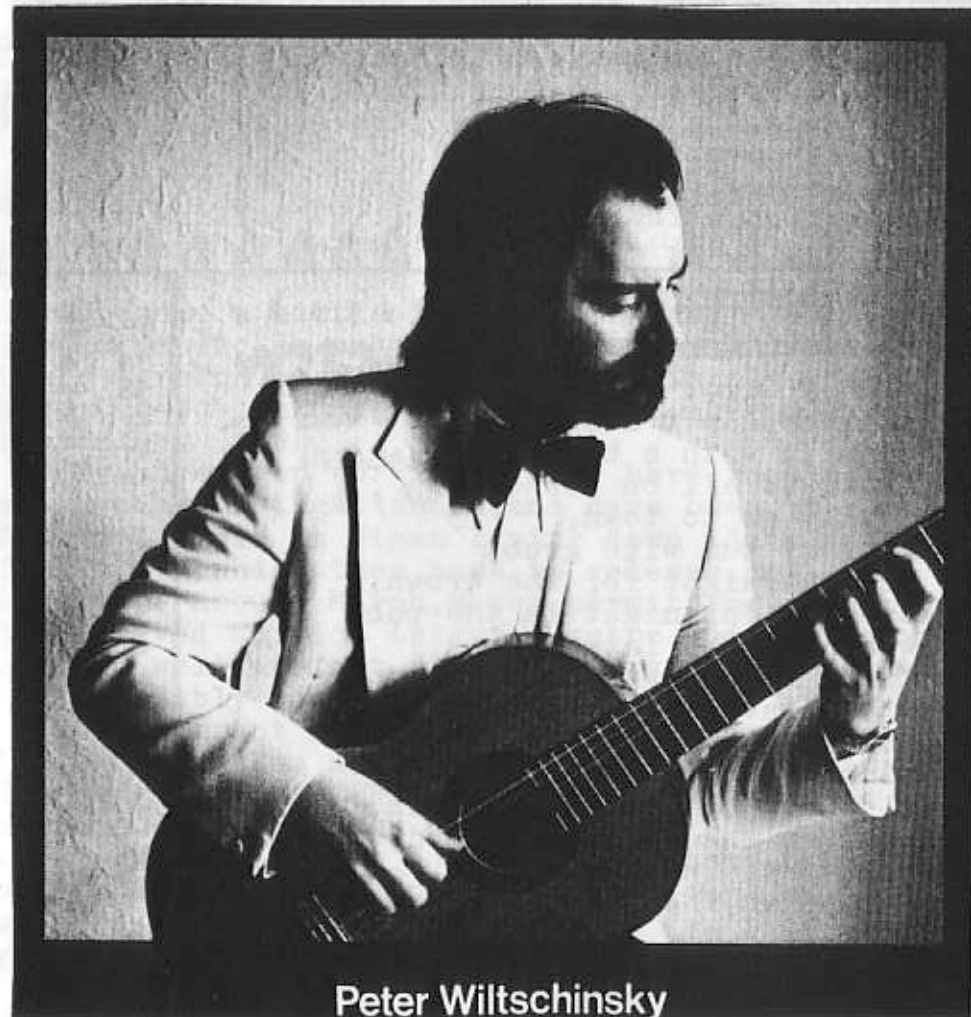
Robin Hill & Peter Wiltschinsky



Robin Hill

Robin Hill, born in Huddersfield in 1953, studied guitar with David Taplin and has participated in master classes by the eminent Brazilian guitarist, Alirio Diaz. In addition to his classical playing, he is in much demand as a session musician, and has played with many world famous artists, and toured extensively abroad. His playing has been described by music critics as "brilliant", "possessing formidable dexterity" and having "superb tonal quality".

Peter Wiltschinsky, born in Doncaster in 1955, studied guitar with Gordon Crosskeys and later with David Taplin. He is the holder of a L.T.C.L. performer's diploma, and has been described by music critics as "a guitarist of uncommon ability", with "excellent technique" and a "marvellous sense of poetry and spontaneity".

The two guitarists first met and played together at music college in 1973. In March 1979 they decided to form a permanent duo and in the relatively short time they have been together, have played many successful recitals and made several television appearances. Both musicians use guitars made by the renowned Oxfordshire Luthier David Rubio.
