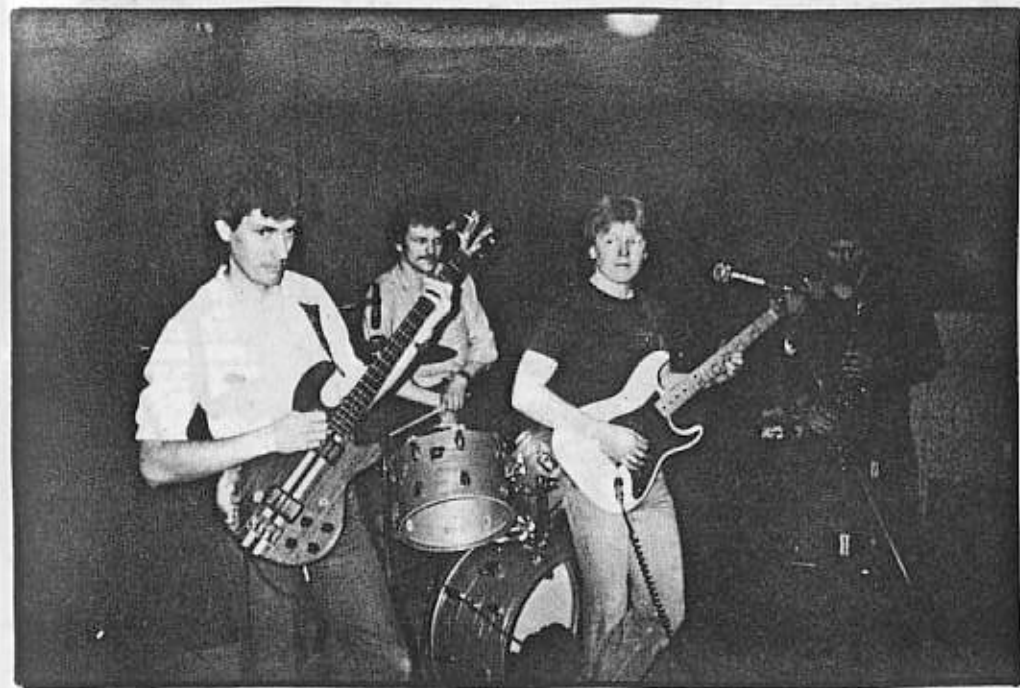
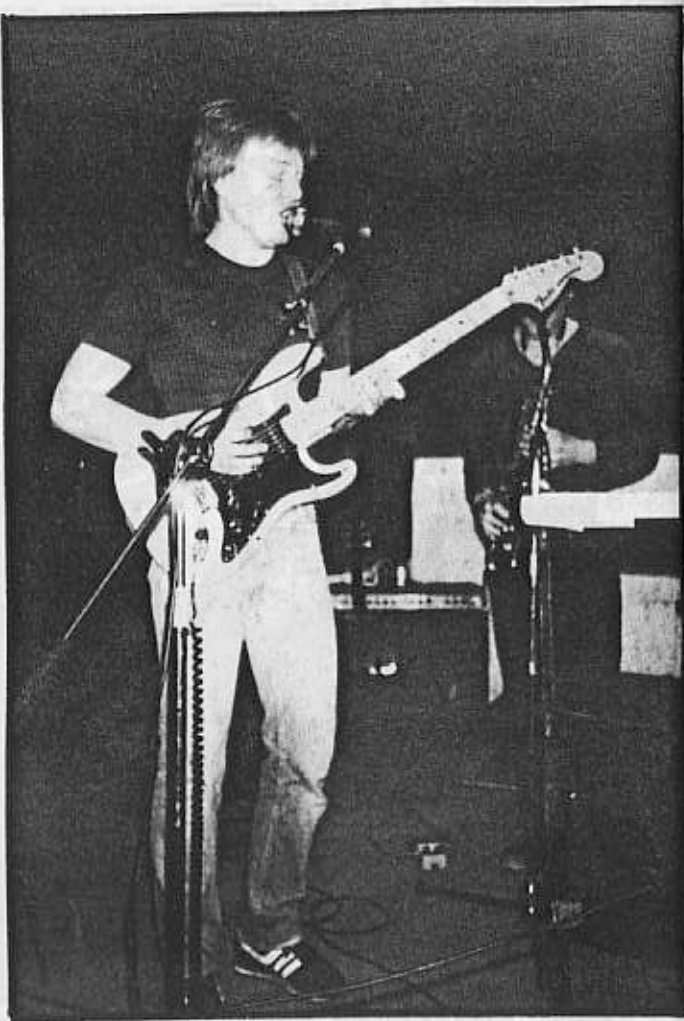


Peppermint

This is the second cassette released by Peppermint Dream in the last four months and although there are six very good tracks on this tape, I feel that it is not as strong as "Shout!" That's not to say that this tape is weak, far from it. "Where's Christopher" is undoubtedly the best track on the tape with some nice guitar and saxophone work, while "Purple Dream" is a good opener. The rest of the songs are well-played "psychedelic/pop" songs but with a tendency to mingle. Whereas most of the songs on "Shout!" were quite different from each other, here the choruses don't remain in your head like they used to do. I think their set is a lot better than the tape, and since their show is a mixture of both tapes, it is much more representative of how good they really are.
