

In the peaceful solitude of the countryside near Hulton Lane Ends (that's between Bolton and Atherton) there lies Leadbeaters Farm. One of the buildings here however, doubles as a recording studio, run by Pete Makin. Of all the local recording studios around the area. Soundlab must surely offer one of the best deals yet. At the moment, there is a TEAC four track which can be used for £25 a day or even £5 an evening! Then within the next month, a sixteen track will be introduced at the cost of only £50 a day. There are also keyboards, an echo unit, pitch transposer, flanger, phaser, chorus etc all for free use by the recording bands. So far, Peppermint Dream, Colours of Crimson, Oh no, It's Them Again and various conglomerations (remember Revolver Rehash) have emerged with some fine recordings, and Soundlab also make personal jingles, eg for mobile discos. I've sketched out a rough map above to give you a vague idea of its whereabouts, but if you want more details and are interested in using Soundlab, ring Pete Makin on Atherton (90) 892193.
